



## **ROUNDS 3 & 4 – SALZBURGRING, AUSTRIA PREVIEW**

### **THE 2010 FIA EUROPEAN TOURING CAR CUP RESUMES IN AUSTRIA NEXT WEEK**

The 2010 FIA European Touring Car Cup resumes this weekend at the Austrian Salzburgring for the second race meeting of the season.

Four months after the opening event at Braga, Portugal, the competitors will race the 4.2km, high-speed racetrack surrounded by Austria's mountains before facing another break of nearly three months before the finale at Franciacorta, Italy.

Twenty cars – 15 in the S2000 class – will take part in the event at the Salzburgring.

#### THOMPSON WON SUPER 2000 CLASS IN BRAGA

Reigning FIA European Super 2000 Cup champion James Thompson emerged on top after the 2010 opening event in Braga.

At the wheel of his Hartmann Racing Honda Accord, the Briton won the first Portuguese race from his Swedish teammate Tomas Engström and Dane racer Kristian Poulsen. He grabbed a podium in the second race to take a slim lead in the series classification.

Thompson had to work hard to chase BMW drivers César Campaniço from Portugal and Kristian Poulsen who were classified first and second in Race 2 respectively.

Competition was close on the Portuguese racetrack, with all the drivers offering a number of exciting fights, even for the midfield positions.

#### LÖHNIG DOMINATED THE SUPER 1600 CLASS

Jens Löhnig from Germany took two comfortable victories in the Super 1600 class at Braga.

Löhnig and his ATM Racing Ford Fiesta ST managed to beat the reigning champion Carsten Seifert twice after chasing him in the early stages of both rounds. Florian Heitmeier, Seifert's teammate at NK Racing Team, finished third in the two races.

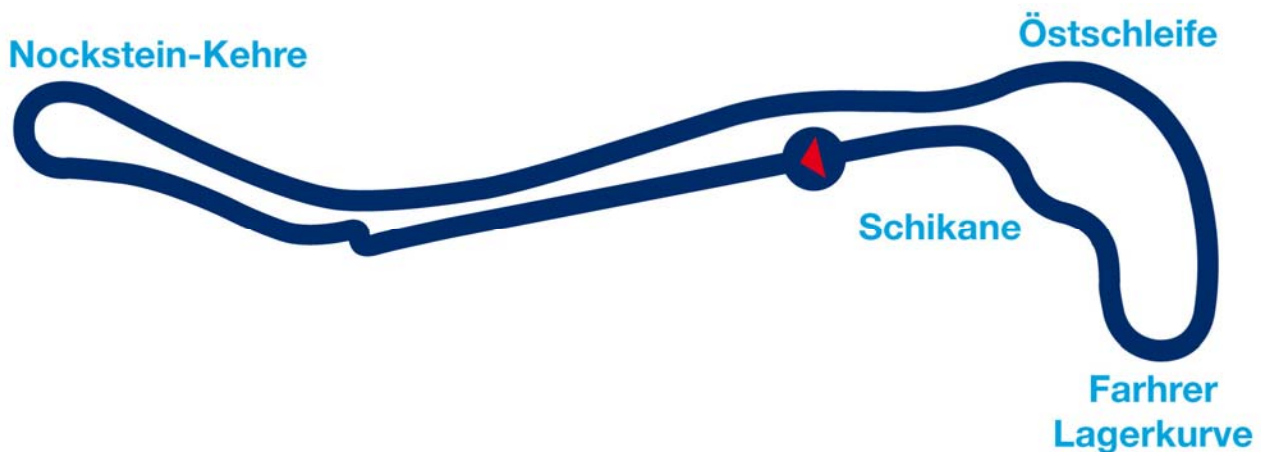
